Energy Efficiency & Retrofit



Take part in our Home Efficiency Survey 2024

As part of ZCH's <u>Retrofit Programme</u>, residents across the Harrogate area are invited to take part in our home energy efficiency survey. North Yorkshire Home Upgrade Grant (HUG)

HUG2 is available to improve efficiency and reduce energy bills for homeowners and private renters. The grant helps to pay for insulation, solar panels, heat pumps and smart heating controls, and is available for homes without mains gas central heating, an annual household income of less than £31,000 or receiving income-related benefits.
