### Retrofit Progamme Homeowner Event - 16th March 2023

Last September, ZCH conducted the Harrogate District Retrofit Home Survey which revealed that 94% of respondents want to explore ways to reduce their home's carbon emissions - with home insulation, solar panels and house batteries being the most popular choices of home improvements.

In response, and in parallel with our two day funded Retrofit Training Course at Harrogate College, we are hosting our first Homeowner Event on 16th March 6.30-8pm. Locally based guest speakers and experts will outline the process of retrofitting and how homeowners go about making improvements.
